 - Accorded time for the production of a video is a minimum of three (3) minutes and a maximum of five (5) minutes.
- 2. **Proof of Registration** at the Canadian university or community college;
- 3. A transcript of your most current academic standing. This is not applicable for anyone who has been out of school for more than two (2) years.

NOTE: The essay or submission from the successful applicant becomes the property of the Workers' History Museum.

Preference may be given to people entering their second or later year of university or community college.

If you are a successful applicant, we will require a picture of the presentation of this award.
